Dear Parents/Guardians

With the increase in the number of COVID-19 cases nationally, our school continues to ensure Safe Management Measures are in place for our students. We hope students and parents can do their part to protect themselves by adopting good hygiene habits and practising social responsibility.

I would like to thank you for your unwavering support in your child's/ward's education and look forward to your continued support to help him/her reach his/her potential.

### 1. Staff Matters

Mrs Nicole Shen, Vice-Principal (Academic), will be going for Leaders in Education Programme (LEP) from 21 March 2022. We wish her all the best in her future endeavours.

### 2. 82nd Founder's Day Celebration

Due to the current situation, schools are discouraged from organising mass activities and large scale events. E-celebrations and activities will be conducted in class to commemorate our Founder's Day.

### 3. Change in P1 Dismissal Timing

As P1 students are familiarised with school routine in Term 1, the dismissal timing will be changed with effect from Monday, 21 March 2022, which is the start of Term 2. The revised timing is

### 4. School Traffic Situation

Parents/Guardians who drive your child/ward to school are to be considerate and refrain from holding up the traffic when your child alight from the car. Ensure that your child/ward is seated on the left side of the car with his/her school bag. Do not alight your child/ward along Marine Terrace, in front of the bus stop. Alight your child at the designated drop off carparks at Block 4, Block 5 or Block 50A.

Traffic congestion builds up along Marine Terrace every morning from 7.10am to 7.25am. During this period, drivers are advised to be patient and give way to pedestrian and public transportation. Refrain from using your car horn to be considerate to the neighbours within the school vicinity.

Parents/Guardians who walk your child/ward to school are encouraged to send them to Gate 1 or 4. We urge parents to move away from the gate areas quickly to allow other parents to drop their child/ward off. This is to prevent congestion at the gates and ensure safety of the students crossing outside the school gate and facilitate movement of cars turning into the school compound.

**5. Health matters**

- Daily temperature-taking with additional visual screening will continue to be carried out for all students and staff. In addition, students and staff who are unwell are advised to seek medical attention.
- Students or their household members who are COVID-19 positive (tested PCR or AG positive) or had been issued Health Risk Notice (HRN), are to inform the school. Students on HRN can return to school if the ART result is negative. Take a photo evidence of your child's (with name and class) ART and send to the school via email ([naps@moe.edu.sg](mailto:naps@moe.edu.sg)) or whatsapp (9623 1926).
- Students are to bring their TraceTogether token with them throughout the school day to facilitate contact tracing by MOH. You may bring your child's/ward's token to the community centre to change for a new one should it be faulty or has run out of battery.

**6. Students who cycle or scoot to school**

Students who ride to school using bicycle or scooter are allowed to park their bicycles or scooters at the waiting area near Gate 4 at their own risk. They are to ensure that their bicycles and scooters are labelled, secured and locked at all times.

Students are reminded to observe road safety when riding on pedestrian pathways and designated areas. They are to refrain from using mobile phones and earphones when riding and always wear protective gears.

**7. Labour Day and Hari Raya Puasa**

As **Monday, 2 May 2022** is public holiday in lieu of Labour Day and Hari Raya Puasa falls on **Tuesday, 3 May 2022**, there will be no school on these 2 days.


We would like to wish all Muslim staff and students Selamat Hari Raya Puasa.
