## 2. School Emergency Preparedness Exercise (EX RHINOS+ : Fire Incident Drill)

As stated in the Term 3 letter to parents sent via PG on 20 June 2024, the school will be conducting the Emergency Preparedness Exercise (Ex Rhino – Fire Drill) on **Friday 19 July 2024**. Please take note that there will be **no remedial lessons** on that day and the school **dismissal is at 12 p.m.** Our school bus vendors and school-based Student Care Centre have been informed about the early dismissal. Students going home by school bus will be picked up at 12.00 p.m. Our school-based SCC will operate from 12.00 p.m. to 7.00 p.m. on that day. If your child is not in Student Care or not taking the school transport, please make the necessary arrangements for your child's dismissal on that day.

### **3. Gifted Education Programme (GEP) Identification Exercise 2024**

The GEP Screening Exercise will be conducted on 15 August 2024 (Thursday) during curriculum time and the GEP Selection Exercise for shortlisted students will be conducted on 15 and 16 October 2024. The exercises will be based on the Primary 1 to Primary 3 English Language and Mathematics syllabus. A separate letter will be sent through Parents' Gateway at a later date to seek your consent for your child to take part in the GEP Screening Exercise. As 15 August 2024 is a school day, your child/ward will still be required to attend school if he/she is not taking part.

The GEP Identification Exercise aims to identify suitable students with high intellectual potential. Test-preparation activities could inflate students' scores and not reflect their actual potential. Students who are not ready to handle the intellectual rigour and demands of the programme will struggle with the enriched curriculum and not benefit fully from it. This would put undue stress on the students and may even cause them to lose confidence and impact their self-esteem.
