P1 Updates (2/2025)

1. School-Home Partnership

a) Communication with Teachers

The Parents Gateway is a one-stop portal that strengthens school-home partnership to support our children in their education journey. All school announcements and consent forms are disseminated via the PG. We strongly encourage all parents/guardians to read and respond to the notifications in PG.

Students are also advised to bring their Student Handbook to school on every school day. They have been guided and reminded by their teachers to record in their handbooks their daily assignments and the instructions given by teachers. Parents may refer to the handbook to get an update on your child's/ward's daily assignments and the instructions given by their teachers.

Our children succeed when schools and parents/guardians work hand in hand to support them in learning self-management skills, taking responsibility and building resilience. We look forward to building a strong and positive School-Home Partnership with you.

b) Establishing a positive school-home partnership

2. Holistic Assessment

As communicated in the Term 1 LM letter, the progress of students' learning will be captured through different assessment modes such as performance tasks and written assignments. Your child/ward will receive the Holistic Development Profile at the end of this semester. Please take note of the Learning Outcomes (LO) for the various subjects in Semester 1. There will be 3 levels of qualitative descriptors to report students' learning progress for each learning outcome in the Holistic Development Profile (HDP).
