Dear Parents/Guardians,

### **2022 P1 First Day of School**

Welcome all Primary 1 students and parents to Ngee Ann Primary School.

Based on MOE's press release on the reopening of school, P1 students will report to school on 4 January 2022 (Tuesday). Only P1 students will report on this day to allow them to ease into the new school routines and be familiar with the school environment.

#### **1) Name Tags (Sent via Mail)**

You will receive an envelope containing your child's name tag via mail. On the first day of school, we will identify your child from the name tag and guide him/her to the class. On the name tag, please fill up the contact details and after school arrangement (e.g. School Bus, Student Care or Dismissal at Gate 1 or Gate 4). Please ensure that your child wears the name tag to school from the first day onwards.

#### **2) TraceTogether (TT) Tokens**

Students are to carry their TT tokens with them daily for Contact Tracing purposes. Please collect TT tokens for your children from any Community Centre/Club. Singaporeans and Permanent Residents who are collecting their tokens for the first time can also request for the TT token to be delivered via post. Details can be found at [token.gowhere.gov.sg](http://token.gowhere.gov.sg).

#### **3) Wearing of Mask**

Students are required to wear their mask at all times. They can remove the mask when eating and drinking. Do pack for your child/ward an additional ziplock bag for him/her to place the mask when he/she remove it during PE lesson or recess.

A spare mask (kept in ziplock bag) should also be packed in the school bag in the event that it needs to be replaced.

Parents are strongly encouraged to label their children's face masks for easy identification.

#### **4) First Day of School (4 Jan 2022, Tuesday, before 7.30 a.m.)**

Each P1 student may be accompanied by at most one parent/guardian on the first day of school. Only vaccinated parents, or unvaccinated parents (including those medically ineligible for the vaccines) with a negative ART self-swab result are allowed to accompany their child. School will check for parents' vaccination status at point of entry through SE(Business) or TraceTogether app. Unvaccinated parents will be required to show a photo of a negative ART result performed within 24 hours prior to entry.

The accompanying parent / guardian may enter the school compound to the parade square. At the Parade Square, the teachers on duty will welcome your child and lead him/her to the assembly area for his/her class. The P1 students will be led to their respective classrooms in batches by the teachers on duty. Parents will take their leave after their child has moved to the classroom. Parents / guardians are reminded to maintain social distancing and avoid intermingling at the parade square and outside school gates.

Due to Safe Management Measures, the school has discontinued the 30-minute viewing during recess time. The school will instead post timely updates of key programmes of the day via Facebook page on 4 January 2022 (Tuesday). On the school's Facebook page, you will see posts of class activities, school tours conducted for the students, recess and school dismissal routines at different times of the day.

You may refer to our school's Facebook page and view the posts in 2021 that were shared with parents of the P1 cohort 2021 (<https://tinyurl.com/6sr845kc>) as a guide. Feedback from parents of P1 cohort 2021 have been positive.

Parents are encouraged to view the photos on Facebook together with your child and listen to your child share their first day of school experiences.

#### **5) Classroom Routine**

In the classroom, the form teachers will guide the students on the morning routine. This include wipe-down procedure, washing of hands and taking temperature. All Primary 1 students will be given a thermometer on the first day. Please ensure that your child brings the thermometer to school daily.

#### **6) Recess Arrangement**

During recess, the students will be assigned designated seats at the canteen. Parents can prepare a lunch box or give some pocket money to your child. Rest assured that there will be teachers on duty in the canteen to assist the students in buying their food. Form teachers will also be at the canteen to monitor and supervise the students during recess.

To help prepare your child on food choices and handling of cash during recess, please find attached the Canteen Stall and Price Guide (Annex A).

## 7) School Dismissal

To ease the congestion, there will be staggered dismissal for the students.

- 4 Jan (Tuesday) to 6 Jan (Thursday), the Primary 1 students will be dismissed at 1 p.m.
- 7 Jan (Friday) the Primary 1 students will be at 12.30 p.m.

This will allow teachers ample time to direct the students to their respective dismissal points.

From 10 Jan onwards, P1 dismissal will be at 1.05 p.m. for Mondays to Thursdays and 12.35 p.m. for Fridays.

## 8) Travel and Health Declaration

If you have travelled overseas during the school holidays, please email the school at [naps@moe.edu.sg](mailto:naps@moe.edu.sg). Provide details such as the country of visit as well as the period travelled. Please inform the school if any of your household members are unwell, on Quarantine order, issued Stay Home Notice or given swab test.

## 9) Social Responsibility

We would like to urge all students and parents/guardians to **reduce intermingling outside the school gates, continue practising good personal hygiene, adhere to SMM and exercise social responsibility.**

Students are reminded to wear masks properly, keep social distancing, bring along the TraceTogether Token for contact tracing purposes, observe MOH/MOE advisory for QO, SHN, HRW and/or LOA see a doctor if unwell and return to school only when fully recovered.

We look forward to welcoming your child/ward to Ngee Ann Primary School.
