#### 2. Assessment Plan

In our effort to align to MOE's direction of nurturing lifelong learners, we need to help our students discover more joy and develop stronger intrinsic motivation in learning. There are adjustments made to reduce school-based assessment load and perceived examination stakes in Ngee Ann Primary School. The P4 students will **not** be taking Mid-Year Examination. This will free up more time and space for greater engagement and deepening of learning.

There will be End-of-Year Examination in Term 4 and two weighted assessments (WA) for the various subjects in Term 2 and 3. More details on the WA will be given at a later date.
