3. 2022 P5 Assessment Matters

This is to allow more time and space for greater engagement and deepening of learning.

There will be End-of-Year Examination in Term 4 and two weighted assessment (WA) for the various subjects in Term 2 and 3. More details on the WA will be given at a later date.
