Dear Parents/Guardians

COMMUNICATION 3/2022

We would like to thank you for your invaluable support towards your child's/ward's holistic education. As we are coming to the end of Term 2, we look forward to your continuous warm support and strong partnership towards an enriching school experience for the students in Term 3.

1. <u>eLearning Day on 27 May 2022</u>

This is to inform that Friday, 27 May 2022 is eLearning Day as well as Meet Parent's Session, there will be no school on that day. Students are to do eLearning in the SLS Learning portal.

2. Achievements

We are proud of our students who have done well in competitions for both academic and non-academic areas. The Record of Achievements for Semester One will be posted on our school's Facebook page.

3. <u>Mid-year School Vacation Travel Plan</u>

With the school vacation drawing near, the school would like to collate our students' travel plans. Furnish us your child/ward's travel details during the school vacation via Parents Gateway for Travel Declaration.

We wish our students and their families a restful break during this vacation.

4. School Dismissal Timing

With the easing of Safe Management Measures, school dismissal for P1 to P6 students will be adjusted to 1.30pm (Mon – Thur) and 1.00pm (Fri) with effect from Term 3.

Parents / Guardians are reminded to arrange for 1 caregiver to pick up your child/ward from the pick-up points and make space for students who are leaving the school. Students with siblings in the upper levels are encouraged to wait for their older siblings at the sibling waiting area within the school before leaving together to the pick-up point.

P5 and P6 students who do not have younger siblings are encouraged to leave via Gate 1 to be picked up by parents at Block 51 and Block 52 public car park. P5 and P6 students may also meet their parents/guardians at Block 5 so that parents/guardians can use the car park serving Blocks 5 to 8 and exit via Block 5 car park towards Marine Crescent.

5. School Recess Arrangement

With effect from Semester 2, Primary 3 and 6 students will consume their food in the classroom during recess. They are encouraged to bring their own reusable cutleries and a lunch box to purchase food from the canteen.

6. Student Well-Being

As we remain vigilant in keeping infectious diseases at bay, we would like you to help us by doing the following:

- a. Parents to immediately seek medical attention for their children who are not feeling well and to allow them to rest at home until they are certified medically fit to attend school. Keep your child's Form Teacher informed as well.
- b. Reinforce the good habit of maintaining a high standard of personal hygiene, for example, the correct way of hand washing.

We would also like to assure you that the well-being of our students is of utmost importance and we will do the necessary to ensure that all the precautionary measures are taken to safeguard their well-being.

7. NE Show

From 2022, the NDP 2022 Organizing Committee has informed that the National Education (NE) Shows 2022 for our Primary 5 students will be held on Saturday, 16 July 2022. More details will be shared at a later date.

8. National Day Celebration

The school will celebrate National Day on Monday, 8 August 2022. Students will report to school at the usual time but they will be dismissed as follows.

If your child/ward is not taking the school bus, do make the necessary transport arrangement. Kindly ensure that your child/ward has his/her breakfast before coming to school as the school canteen will not be operating on that day.

Students are encouraged to be attired in red and white. However, they may wear their school uniform if they do not have any suitable red and/or white clothing. There will be no lessons on that day. Students are to bring along a small bag containing a story book, writing materials and a water bottle.

<u>Tuesday</u>, 9 <u>August 2022</u> is a public holiday and <u>Wednesday</u>, 10 <u>August 2022</u> is a school holiday. There will be no school on these 2 days. School will resume on Thursday, 11 August 2022.

9. PSLE Oral & Listening Comprehension Examinations 2022

The above examinations for P6 students will be conducted on the following dates:

Oral Examinations

- 15 and 16 August 2022 (Monday & Tuesday)

Listening Comprehension

- 16 September 2022 (Friday)

All P1 to P5 students are not required to report to school on these days. For P6 students who are taking the school bus, do make the necessary transport arrangement.

10. P6 Preliminary Examinations 2022

The P6 Preliminary Examination will be conducted from Wednesday, 17 August 2022 to Tuesday, 23 August 2022. As the P6 students are taking their Preliminary Examination in preparation for the PSLE, all topics will be covered.

11. <u>Tentative End-of-Year Semester Assessment 2 (EYE) Dates</u>

The End-Of-Year written examination for P3 to P5 students will be conducted tentatively from 26 October to 1 November 2022. We will furnish you with more details nearer the dates. There is no End-of-Year Examination for Primary 1 and 2 students.

12. School Examination Policy

We would like to remind you of the school examination policy:

- Students must sit for each paper strictly according to the date and time stipulated in the examination timetable.
- There will be no make-up papers for students who are absent on examination days.
- Students who are ill or are covered by medical certificates* (MC) on the day of the paper are not allowed to sit for it.
- Students who are on medical leave are required to produce their MC immediately upon their return to school. Their marks will be computed accordingly. No marks will be awarded for the paper if there are no supporting MC.
- * Parents who wish for their child to take the papers during the period covered by MC must produce doctor's memo to certify that the child is fit for school.

13. Term 3 Calendar of Activities

The Calendar of Activities for Term 3 is attached for your information. We will keep you updated if there are any changes.

14. Communication Matters

The school was alerted to some speculations and insensitive remarks made by parents/guardians via social media platforms such as Facebook, Whatsapp chats and Instagram towards other parents and their children. Please be mindful that such comments may incite unnecessary anxiety and unpleasantness.

15. Primary 1 Registration Exercise – Phase 1

With reference to our announcement via Parents Gateway dated 22 April 2022, Primary 1 registration for Phase 1 is open for registration. Phase 1 is applicable for Singapore Citizen (SC) or Permanent Resident (PR) child born between 2 Jan 2016 and 1 Jan 2017 (both dates inclusive) and has a sibling studying in our school.

If you have a SC or PR child eligible for Phase 1, submit the online form at https://go.gov.sg/p1onlineform by Monday, 27 June 2022. The school will contact you if additional clarifications and / or documents are required.
