English Language	Listening Listen attentively and follow simple instructions.
	 Speaking Follow communication etiquette such as taking turns, and using appropriate eye contact and volume in conversations or discussions.
	Reading Read aloud Primary 1 texts (e.g. STELLAR texts) with accuracy, fluency and expression.
	Understand Primary 1 texts (e.g. STELLAR texts) and are able to identify simple aspects of fiction (e.g. main characters and setting).
	 Writing Write a simple paragraph of at least 3 sentences to recount appropriately sequenced events.
Mother Tongue Languages	Listening Listening attentively to short, simple spoken content related to daily life.
	 Speaking and Spoken interaction Ask and/or respond to simple questions related to daily life.

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	 Reading Read aloud Primary 1 texts with accuracy. Understand Primary 1 texts and are able to identify some details with guidance. Writing Write words, phrases and simple sentence(s) about daily life with guidance (CL/ML) / Write words and simple phrases with guidance (TL).
Mathematics	 Add and subtract numbers. Understand Multiplication and Division Tell time to 5 minutes Measure and compare lengths of objects
Art	 Play with a variety of materials and tools to make art. Show interest in looking at a variety of artworks. Talk about what they see, feel and experience using basic art vocabulary of elements and principles of design such as lines, shapes, colours, patterns and proportions.
Physical Education	Games & Sports Demonstrate a range of motor skills in rolling, catching and throwing a variety of objects.
	 Outdoor Education Move across a variety of ground surfaces in a familiar environment safely and confidently.
	 Physical Health and Fitness Acquire a range of personal safety practices in school, at home and when using the road.
	 Physical Health and Fitness Demonstrate good health practices (drinking water, food choices and physical activities) and habits in personal care (eye care and UV-protection) and hygiene.
Music	Listen and Respond to Music Describe the sound produced by instruments and how they are played.
	 Create Music Create rhythmic ostinato of at least 2 bars to accompany a melodic piece. Use graphic or standard notation to record music ideas.
	 Perform Music – Playing Instruments Play rhythmic and melodic patterns on pitched and non-pitched classroom instruments expressively, with accurate rhythm and pitch (when applicable).

Social Studies	 Identify the different roles that students play at home, in class and in school. Share thoughts and feelings with group members, with teacher guidance. State ways to help people and care for the places around them.
