3. Gifted Education Programme (GEP) Identification Exercise 2023

The GEP Screening Exercise will be conducted on 17 August 2023 (Thursday) during curriculum time and Selection Exercise for shortlisted students will be conducted on 17 and 18 October 2023. The exercises will be based on the Primary 1 to Primary 3 English Language

and Mathematics syllabus. A separate letter with more details will be sent out via PG nearer to the date to seek your consent. These exercises are not compulsory. As 17 August 2023 is a school day, your child/ward will still be required to attend school if he/she is not taking the

GEP Screening Exercise.

The GEP Identification Exercise aims to identify suitable students with high intellectual potential. Test-preparation activities could inflate students' scores and not reflect their actual potential. Students who are not ready to handle the intellectual rigour and demands of the programme will struggle with the enriched curriculum and not benefit fully from it. This would put undue stress on the students and may even cause them to lose confidence and impact

their self-esteem.
